If you want to rent the park shelter houses for a party, reunion or graduation this year, be sure to book in advance, as reservations are already starting to come in! Open Shelter Houses are FREE to reserve and the Enclosed Shelter is \$15.00/day. Call or email City Hall to check availability!!

After reviewing the surveys that were returned, and taking into account Postal Service operational needs, retail hours for this location will likely be:


