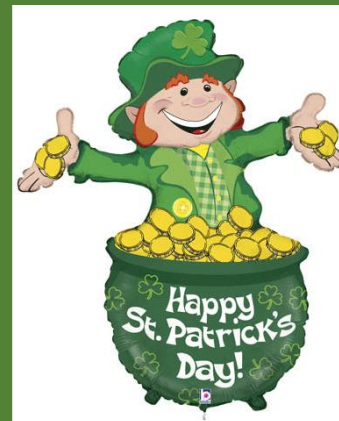

On the Water Bill going out MARCH 25th, you will notice a “PRIMACY” FEE on it. This is a yearly fee that the City collects for the Missouri Department of Natural Resources. This user fee, paid by the customers of Missouri’s public water supply systems, supports the department’s efforts to ensure Missourians are provided safe drinking water.

News from Alma Police Department

The Alma Police Department has been receiving many complaints that dogs are running at large and unattended by their owners. As the City **DOES** have a LEASH LAW, the Alma Police Department does have the authority to have your dog impounded at **YOUR** cost or a summons may be issued to the registered owner for each offense. Keep your dog restrained with a leash when you are not on your property. Do not let your dog(s) roam free early in the morning or late at night to use the bathroom unattended. When walking your dog, please be respectful and restrict your dog from peeing or defecating on other citizen’s yards and vehicles.



nixle

The City of Alma now has Nixle messaging. The service, created by Nixle, LLC delivers trustworthy and important neighborhood-level public safety and community event notifications by web, e-mail, and cell phone. The broadcast information originates from the City of Alma.

Nixle is simple, trusted and available at no cost. There is no spam or advertising associated with Nixle messages.

Residents may learn more and register for the service <http://local.nixle.com/alma-police-department-mo>. Citizens are also encouraged to spread the word on this new service so that others may benefit from the notifications.

Nixle is built exclusively to provide secure and reliable communications. Its authenticated service connects public safety agencies to residents in real time, delivering information to geographically targeted consumers over their cell phones (via text messages), through e-mails and through Web access.

If you wish to receive notices from the City of Alma & the Alma Fire Department, please click on the link above. The registration is super easy. You may register for emails or texts.

At this time we will be sending out emergency notifications to residents. Such as when we are having severe weather, the City & Fire Department can notify residents the status of the weather and not solely rely on the residents to listen for the sirens and the all clear messages. The City will also send out any alerts regarding boil orders and water line breaks.

While logged in you can search for notifications from other groups, such as Lafayette County Sheriff's Dept., which sends out messages alerting citizens of police issues or if there are road closures and inclement weather warnings.
