Lafayette County residents may bring in, at no cost, household hazardous materials. Citizens volunteering on-site for the program will direct you to the loading site, unload your vehicle, and have you on your way within a few minutes without you having to get out of your vehicle. Due to cost restrictions, only the first 250 vehicles with household hazardous materials can be accepted. The City of Alma will be hosting this event this year so there will be many of people throughout Lafayette County coming here for the drop-off. With there being a limit on cars being able to drop off be sure to get there early to ensure you are able to dispose of your items!

Items you may bring: Weed killer, all paint, furniture polish, paintbrush cleaner, wood preservative, drain cleaner, motor oil, metal polish, paint thinner, fiberglass epoxy, gas, kerosene, floor care products, paint stripper, moth balls, anti-freeze, old medicines, transmission fluid, turpentine, herbicide, insect poisons, paint remover, car battery, fluorescent glass tubes, varnish, fungicide, pool chemicals, battery acid, C-cell batteries, rat poison, pesticides, fire extinguishers, butane cylinders, BBQ pit cylinders

Items that WILL NOT be accepted: explosives-ammunition, shot gun shells, dynamite, pressured cylinders, mercury salts, low-level radioactive waste, smoke detectors.

**PLEASE mark any unknown materials with any information you may have about the materials.*

***Electronics** can be dropped off at the Alma Road District Shed which is located on the corner of South County Rd. and Goodwin Rd.. right on the South edge of town.



ALMA CITY-WIDE CLEAN-UP

Heartland Waste will be collecting residential trash as usual but will also be collecting large items and yard waste.

Yard waste needs to be in biodegradable bags or contained in a trash can. Branches can not be longer than four (4) feet in length and must be bundled.

The clean-up/large items can be pretty much anything extra that you need to get rid of. They only things that they will not pick up are: Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners (due to them containing Freon), concrete, and bricks.

If you have something that is questionable please contact City Hall so that it can be approved by the trash company.

REMINDER FROM THE ALMA POLICE DEPARTMENT



With the weather warming up now, many of us will have to begin mowing our yards. As a reminder, the City of Alma does have an Ordinance in place regulating how tall your grass, weeds and other vegetation can get.

Ordinance No. 522 pertaining to Nuisances and in Section 12, it states that every owner or persons having control of any property with in the City limits, either occupied or vacant, shall cut and keep cut all weeds, tall grass, and other vegetation growing upon such premises and parkway, and any person violating provisions of this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and every day such condition is permitted to remain after conviction shall constitute a separate offense. Whenever, such weeds, tall grass or other vegetation shall attain the height of eight (8) inches, it shall be deemed a public nuisance.

The Police Department will serve notice to the owner of the property and said owner of property will have five (5) days which to cut said vegetation. If owner fails to comply with the notice within five (5) days, a citation will be issued for each day that the vegetation is not removed thereafter.
