The burn pile that is located by the lagoon is a service to the Alma citizens to use to dispose of any yard waste that they may have. Recently city employees have had to remove multiple items from the pile that are not allowed. If this service continues to be misused, the City will have to restrict when you are allowed to dump, which causes an inconvenience to the citizens that use it properly. You are not allowed to dump any wood materials that contain nails or metal, sheet rock, furniture, household fixtures, any metal objects, and any other items that are not biodegradable. Yard waste that is contained in garbage bags is allowed. Also, the burn pile is only to be set on fire by a City employee. We have also had trouble with citizens setting the pile on fire which has caused the mulch to catch on fire that has been dumped by tree trimming companies. The mulch that is left down there is free for anyone to use and the City has used it in past for landscaping.



NEWS FROM THE ALMA FIRE DEPARTMENT

As we are amidst tornado and severe thunderstorm season the Alma Fire Department wants to make sure everyone is educated and prepared in case of an emergency. If there is a threat of a tornado near or approaching Alma, the Fire Department will sound the tornado siren. They will continue to sound the siren until all threats of danger have been cleared. At that time the sirens will cease and that will be your notification that everything is clear and that you may leave your safe place. During business hours, storm shelters will be available at City Hall, State Bank, Santa Fe High School, and Trinity Lutheran School. City Hall will be opened after business hours if there is a threat during the evening or though the night.
