News from the Alma Police Department

With the 4th of July fast approaching, many of you will be purchasing fireworks to celebrate. The Police Department would like to remind you that there is an Ordinance in place regulating the times and types of fireworks that can be discharged in the city limits. At no time shall “bottle rockets” be sold or discharged within the City limits of Alma. Fireworks may be discharged between 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on July 1-3 and between 8:00 a.m. and Midnight on July 4. Fireworks are prohibited on private property without owner’s consent; on City owned property; within 100 feet of any premises providing for the sale of gasoline or any other explosive or combustible materials; within a designated school zone. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$500.00 or by imprisonment not exceeding 90 days.



Also, a reminder to remove any valuables out of your vehicles and to lock your vehicles and homes over the 4th of July weekend to deter any vandalism or theft.
