Now that Spring has *FINALLY* arrived many citizens have been working hard in their yards. The City is glad that there is a place for you to dispose of your yard waste to keep our City looking so nice! Please be diligent not to dispose of anything other than yard waste in the burn pile. Lumber is accepted as long as ALL nails, screws, metal, asbestos, & etc. have been removed. If you are unsure if an item is permitted in the burn pile, please get prior approval from City Hall. When unloading your yard waste, **PLEASE** unload **IN** the burn pile area and not in the middle or near the road. This has occurred in the past blocking the road for maintenance at the lagoon or for other citizens needing to dump to dump their yard waste.

Also, **ONLY** City employees are allowed to light the burn pile on fire!!



Tree trimming companies do leave mulch at the burn pile which the public is welcome to take!

Motion carried by vote and Marshall instructed by Chairman in accordance with same. Motion made and seconded that the clerk notify all parties owning property on either side of ^{Lincoln} ~~George~~ Street to build a sidewalk either of brick or plank said sidewalks not to be less than three (3) feet wide. Motion adopted by vote. Motion made and seconded that on and after the 8th day of May 1904 The Ordinance entitled "An ordinance to prohibit stock from running at large" be enforced. Motion carried and clerk instructed to post notices to that effect. Motion to adjourn carried by vote.

Regular Meeting May 3, 1904

Board of Trustees for the Village of Alma met in regular session Tuesday eve May 3. On roll call all members responded. Minutes of last meeting were read and adopted by vote. Bill of John Dierker for \$5.00 presented, allowed, and ordered paid.

Motion made and seconded that L.E. Johnson be elected street commissioner for the following year at a salary of \$15.00 per term.

Motion carried by vote and Mr. Johnson declared elected. Motion made and seconded that all parties who have property obstructing the streets, alleys, and sidewalks of the village be notified by Village Marshall to remove the same.

Motion carried by vote and Marshall instructed by Chairman in accordance with same. Motion made and seconded that the clerk notify all parties owning property on either side of Lincoln Street to build a sidewalk either of brick or plank said sidewalks not to be less than three (3) feet wide. Motion adopted by vote.

Motion made and seconded that on and after the 8th day of May 1904 The Ordinance entitled "An ordinance to prohibit stock from running at large" be enforced.

Motion carried and clerk instructed to post notices to that effect.

Motion to adjourn carried by vote.
