Election Time!

Reminder that anyone interested in running for Alderman Ward 1 or Alderman Ward 2 must file at City Hall by January 19, 2016 at 12:30 p.m. Candidate filing is for the April 5, 2016 General Municipal Election. If you have any questions, please contact City Hall.

Also, if you have recently moved to Alma or even moved from the North or South side of town (which changes what Ward you live in), you can fill out a Voter Registration Card at City Hall so that you don't have to make a special trip to the County Clerk's office. Be sure to get this done by March 9, 2016 to ensure you are able to vote in April!

Be sure to Register your dog(s) for 2016! The fee is \$2.00 per dog and you must provide a current Rabies vaccination record. All dogs within the Alma City limits **MUST** to be registered whether an indoor or outdoor dog, to avoid a fine.
