Mowing Bids

The City of Alma will be accepting sealed bids for the 2016 mowing season until March 1, 2016. The properties that will be involved are the City Park, City Storage Shed, and Maplewood Cemetery. If you have questions regarding the location of these properties, boundary lines or any other requirements you may contact City Hall or pick up a Job Description at the office. Council requests a total mowing season bid (not broken out per time mowed) to be submitted by 12:30 pm on March 1, 2016 for approval at the Council Meeting that night.

The City of Alma has the right to reject any and all bids submitted.
